

DEED DESCRIPTION
FOR
LEVI FAUSNIGHT

Situated in the Village of New Concord, Union Township, Muskingum County, Ohio, and being a part of Section #1, Township #1 north, Range #5 west, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a cut notch in the sidewalk at the north edge of Main St. and the southeast corner of Lot #3 from the plat of West Concord found in Book #1, page #37 recorded November 15, 1856, said cut notch is N $83^{\circ} 35'$ E, a distance of 56.00 feet from the east line of Comin Street and the north line of Main Street, thence N $06^{\circ} 25'$ W, a distance of 101.00 feet to an iron pin set, thence N $83^{\circ} 35'$ E, a distance of 40.04 feet to an iron pin set, thence S $10^{\circ} 39' 08''$ E, a distance of 101.28 feet to a cut notch in the sidewalk and on the north line of Main Street, thence with the north line of Main Street, S $83^{\circ} 35'$ E, a distance of 47.52 feet to the beginning and containing 0.102 acres more or less, and being all of the property conveyed in volume 676, page 252 of the deed records of Muskingum County, Ohio.

Subject to all encumbrances or leases of public record.

Iron pins set are 5/8 inch rebar.

Bearings are for angle purposes only.
