70-15-10-30-000 (1.891 Acres)

Situated in the Southwest Quarter of Section 10, T-1-N, R-7-W, U.S.M.L., Washington Township, Muskingum County, Ohio. Being the lands of Donald and Gloria Adams as conveyed in Deed Book 516 page 550 of the Muskingum County Deed Records, and being described as follows:

- Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of section 10; thence, N.88°55'00"W. a record distance of 1,657 feet to a point; thence, S.01°05'00"W. a record distance of 365 feet to a point; thence, N.26°05'00"E. a record distance of 60.00 feet to a point; thence, S.82°36'31"E. a record distance of 209.00 feet along the South line of the lands, now or formerly, owned by D. Stutes, Et Al, (1131/163) to a found iron pin marking the Northeast corner of the lands, now or formerly, owned by H. & M. Milstead (1111/257), **BEING THE POINT OF BEGINNING;**
- thence, S.82°36'30"E. a distance of 148.42 feet along said Stutes lands to a set rebar on the Northwest corner of the lands, now or formerly, owned by A. Hayes (575/550);
- thence, S.00°13'43"E. a distance of 515.78 feet along the west line of said Hayes lands and the West line of the lands, now or formerly, owned by C. Mox (990/368) to a point in the center of State Route 93, passing a found concrete monuement at 246.36 feet and a found axle at 486.04 feet;
- thence, S.63°48'20"W. a distance of 69.81 feet along the centerline of Said State Route to a point;
- thence, S.71°40'49"W. a distance of 90.02 feet along the centerline of Said State Route to a point;
- thence, N.00°06'41"W. a distance of 593.98 feet along the East line of the H. Milstead lands to the point of beginning, passing a found axle at 29.72 feet and a found iron pin at 37.52 feet;



SURVEY PLAT FOR DONALD ADAMS


SITUATED IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 10, T-1-N, R-7-W, U.S.M.L.,
