## PARCEL 70-50-01-02-000 1.991 ACRES

Commencing at the Southeast Corner of Lot 19, Richard Dickson's Subdivision, as recorded in Replat Book 1 Page 200 of the records of the Muskingum County Recorder's Office, also being a westerly corner of Lot 21 of Muskingum Mining Subdivision, as recorded in Replat Book 1 Page 104 of the Muskingum County Recorder's Office, thence coincident with the southerly line of said Dickson's Lot 19 South 76°18′56″ West a distance of 276.50 feet to a 5/8 inch diameter capped rebar (1) found on the Northeast corner of a parcel of land now or formerly conveyed to Coal Run Storage LLC, by a deed recorded in Official Record 3134, Page 542 of the records of the Muskingum County Recorder's Office;

Thence coincident with the easterly line of said Coal Run Storage South 39°41′04″ East a distance of 231.00 feet to a capped rebar set near a 1 1/2 inch diameter PVC post (2) found at the northeast corner of the subject parcel, the POINT OF BEGINNING of the parcel herein described;

Thence following the easterly line of the subject parcel the following 2 courses:

- 1. South 39°41'04" East a distance of 88.44 feet to a point;
- South 46°06′04" East a distance of 239.77 feet to a capped rebar set on the Southeast corner of the subject parcel and the Northeast corner of a parcel of land now or formerly conveyed to Kathy M Emerson, by a deed recorded in Deed Volume 1136, Page 273 of the records of the Muskingum County Recorder's Office;

Thence coincident with the southerly line of the subject parcel and the northerly line of said Emerson South 53°10′53″ West, a distance of 250.10 feet to a 5/8 inch diameter rebar (14) found at the southwest corner of the subject parcel, also being a point on the easterly line of a parcel of land now or formerly conveyed to RKDC LLC, by a deed recorded in Official Record 2677, Page 684 of the records of the Muskingum County Recorder's Office;

Thence coincident with the westerly line of the subject parcel the following 4 courses:

- 1. North 17°06′33" West, a distance of 97.36 feet to a point;
- 2. North 54°19'31" West, a distance of 268.17 feet to a point;
- 3. (L1) South 76°18'56" West, a distance of 81.07 feet to a point;
- 4. (L2) North 39°40′59″ West, a distance of 50.44 feet to a point witness by a 5/8 inch diameter capped rebar (28) bearing (L3) North 61°55′40″ East, a distance of 4.83 feet;

Thence coincident with the northerly line of the subject parcel and the southerly line of said Coal Run Storage North 70°41′00″ East, a distance of 348.02 feet, returning to the POINT OF BEGINNING of the parcel herein described.
