- #1- THENCE North 78 degrees 20 minutes 00 seconds West 139.81 feet along the common line for said Lots #7 & #8 to an iron pin (set) at a corner of the Cincinnati & Muskingum Valley Railroad property recorded in Deed Book Volume 130, Page 22 (Now Conrail Railroad);
- #2- THENCE North 25 degrees 24 minutes 00 seconds East 76.47 feet through said Lot #7, along the east line of said railroad property, being parallel to and 60 feet from the center line for said railroad, to an iron pin (set) on the South line of the V Fleece property recorded in Deed Book Volume 932, Page 34;
- #3- THENCE South 76 degrees 20 minutes 00 seconds East 123.32 feet continuing through said Lot #7 and along the common line for said Fleming & Fleece properties to an unmarked point near the center of a shared driveway mentioned in previous deed references, said point being on the common line for said Lot #7 and Lake Drive, passing an iron pin (set) at 87.73 feet;
- #4- THENCE along a curve to the left having, a chord bearing South 12 degrees 58 minutes 30 seconds West 70.00 feet, a radius of 2889.79 feet, and arc length of 70.00 feet, along said common line for Lot #7 and Lake drive to the place of beginning, containing 0.22 acres.
