thence, from said Point of Beginning continuing with the south line of Section 26 and the north line of Section 6, South 89\*10'54" West a distance of 11.00 feet to an iron pin set at the northwest corner of a 0.55 acres tract as conveyed to E. Phillis by Deed Volume 943, Page 287 of the Muskingum County Recorder's Office;

thence, with the west line of said 0.55 acres Phillis property, South 05°01'45" East a distance of 170.57 feet to a point in the centerline of Brush Creek, passing through an iron pin set at a distance of plus 140.57 feet (Note: Said point in the centerline of Brush Creek being located for reference South 35^06'26" West a distance of 17.25 feet from an iron pin found capped "R.L.S. 5410".);

thence North 88°59'45" West a distance of 99.54 feet to a point on the north edge of Brush Creek;

thence, with the north right-of-way line of said old railroad (tan 80.00 feet wide right-of-way as conveyed and described in the First Tract of the Sixth Parcel of Deed Volume 539, Page 846), South 63°16'15" East a distance of 469.80 feet to an iron pin set in the west line of a 0.49 acres tract as conveyed to Julia Bowers by Deed Volume 838, Page 3 of the Muskingum County Recorder's Office, passing through an iron pin set at a distance of plus 229.68 feet;

thence, with the west line of said Bowers property, South 27013'45" West a distance of 20.00 feet to a point at the southwest corner of said Bowers tract which is located in the centerline of survey of Township Road No. 1206 (Webster Street); 👆
