Commencing at an iron pin found at the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of section 3; thence on Muskingum--Perry County line South $5^{\circ} 39' 42''$ West 1679.51 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Elm Street; thence along North line of Elm Street South $81^{\circ} 12' 00''$ East 144.18 feet to an axle found, the place of beginning, passing an axle found at 72.18 feet; thence leaving Elm Street North $8^{\circ} 48' 00''$ East 130.00 feet to an iron pin set; thence South $81^{\circ} 12' 00''$ East 67.00 feet to an iron pin set; thence South $8^{\circ} 48' 00''$ West 130.00 feet to an iron pin set on the North line of Elm Street; thence along the North line of Elm Street North $81^{\circ} 12' 00''$ West 67.00 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.20 acres more or less.

Excepting a 16.00 foot perpetual right-of-way across the North end to Orla G. Gordon and heirs.
