

Being 1.944 acres, more or less, all of parcel 17-17-77-04-35, part of the south half of the fourth quarter of township I north, range 8 west, United States Military Lands, in the township of Falls, in the county of Muskingum, in the State of Ohio, and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the centerline of State Route 146, Newark Road, said point being the northwest corner of Locust Springs Subdivision, Plat Book 7, page 59 and from said point a 3/4" pipe found at the northwest corner of Lot 17 of Locust Springs, bears, S.13°16'00"W. 30.82';

thence, along the property line of Paul P. & Rita O. Zigo, 465-164, the following 3 courses:

- 1. thence, N.27°19'00"W. 149.63' to a 5/8" steel pin set:
- 2. thence, N.13°16'00"E. 793.68' to a 5/8" steel pin set;
- 3. thence, continuing N.13°16'00"E. 30.82' to a point in the centerline of State Route 146, Newark Road:

along the centerline of State Route 146, Newark Road, S.63°30'00"E. 100.00' to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, containing 1.944 acres, more or less, including public road right-of-way and is subject to all easements, rights-of-way, or restrictions, whether recorded or implied.

Bearings are based on Deed Book 1049, page 73, N.63°30'00"W. and are for angular calculations only. All 5/8" steel pins set are 30" long with plastic cap marked "E.R.D. 7142".
