Abele, (OR 2733-527), and the principal place of beginning;

Thence through said Fracker lands, North 16 degrees 20 minutes 59 seconds West, 148.72 feet to an iron pin set on the south line of lands presently owned by James Fracker, (DR 1156-945);

Thence along said Fracker's south line North 73 degrees 42 minutes 47 seconds East, 214.66 feet to a point in the centerline of Friendship Drive, (St. Rte. 83, R\W 60'), passing an iron pin found at 184.70 feet;

Thence along the centerline of said Drive, South 19 degrees 48 minutes 47 seconds East, 149.17 feet to a point on the northeast corner of said Abele lands;
