Thence along the south line of Outlot 2, North 86 degrees 12 minutes 34 seconds West, 402.03 feet to a point at the southwest corner of Outlot 2;

Thence along the west line of Outlot 2, North 05 degrees 00 minutes 09 seconds West, 385.62 feet to an iron pin found on the southwest corner of lands presently owned by R. E. Jr. and K. J. Cook, (DR 956-133), passing an iron pin set on the right of way of St. Rte. 40 at 69.08 feet;

Thence along the south line of said Cook lands North 86 degrees 29 minutes 53 seconds East, 134.00 feet to an iron pin set on the southeast corner of said Cook lands;

Thence along the east line of said Cook lands, North 09 degrees 03 minutes 32 seconds West, 132.00 feet to an iron pin set on the south line of a 49.5 feet wide street;

Thence along the south line of said street, the following two courses:

- 1.) North 82 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East, 7.57 feet to an iron pin set;
- 2.) South 74 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East, 356.49 feet to the principal place of beginning, containing 4.64 acres more or less, and 0.52 acres being in the St. Rte. 40 Right of Way.

- 2.) North 74 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West, 26.09 feet to a point in the centerline of said
- 15 feet wide easement, and the principal place of beginning;

Thence along the centertine and through Lot No. 59, South 16 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West, 132.00 feet, to the north line of a 49.5 feet wide street and the terminus of said easement, containing 0.05 acres more or less.
