Gardner, by deed of record in Deed Volume 1040, Page 269, all references being to those of record in the Muskingum County Recorder's Office, said 0.477 acre parcel being further described as follows: 0.4477

Beginning for reference at the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 19:

thence southeasterly along the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 19, South 89°48'14" East, 343.55 feet to an iron pin set marking the northwesterly corner of said Gardner tract, said iron pin being the northwesterly corner and the True Point of Beginning of the hereon described 0.447 acre parcel;

thence continuing southeasterly along said Section line, South 89°48'14" East, 110.95 feet to an existing iron pin marking the southeasterly corner of that 4.829 acre tract as conveyed to The Trustees of Jackson Township, by deed of record in Deed Volume 1089, Page 548;


thence with what represents a new line through said Gardner tract, South 48°23'57" West, 526.56 feet to an existing iron pin;

thence northeasterly along the northerly line of the Gardner tract, the same being the southerly line of the Frazeysburg Cemetery Lands, North 38°56′23″ East, 449.96 feet to the True Place of Beginning, and containing 0.447 acres more or less, according to a survey performed by Graham Surveying in January, 2000, passing an existing iron pin at 224.61 feet.

Bearings in the above described 0.447 acre parcel are based on the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 19 as being South 89°48′14″ East.

All iron pins set are 5/8" in diameter by 30" in length rebars with yellow surveyors caps marked "Graham, 7952".
