

Situated in the State of Ohio, Muskingum County, Jackson Township, Village of Frazeysburg, and more particuarly described as follows:

Beginning at the north east corner of Lot.No. 13 of J. W. Fraziers Addition; thence with the south line of First Street south 89 degrees 38 minutes 45 seconds east **3**/2.00 feet to an iron pin ( set ), said pin being the true place of beginning for the tract herein to be described; thence continuing with the south line of First Street south 89 degrees 38 minutes 45 seconds east 100.00 feet to an iron pin ( set ); thence leaving said south line south 00 degrees 07 minutes 30 seconds west 122.86 feet to the center of the Penn Central Rail Road, passing through an iron pin ( set ) at 92.86 feet; thence with the center of said rail road south 66 degrees 25 minutes 07 seconds west 109.21 feet to a point; thence leaving said rail road north 00 degrees 07 minutes 30 seconds east 167.17 feet to the place of beginning, passing through an iron pin ( set ) at 30.00 feet, containing .332 acres more or less.
