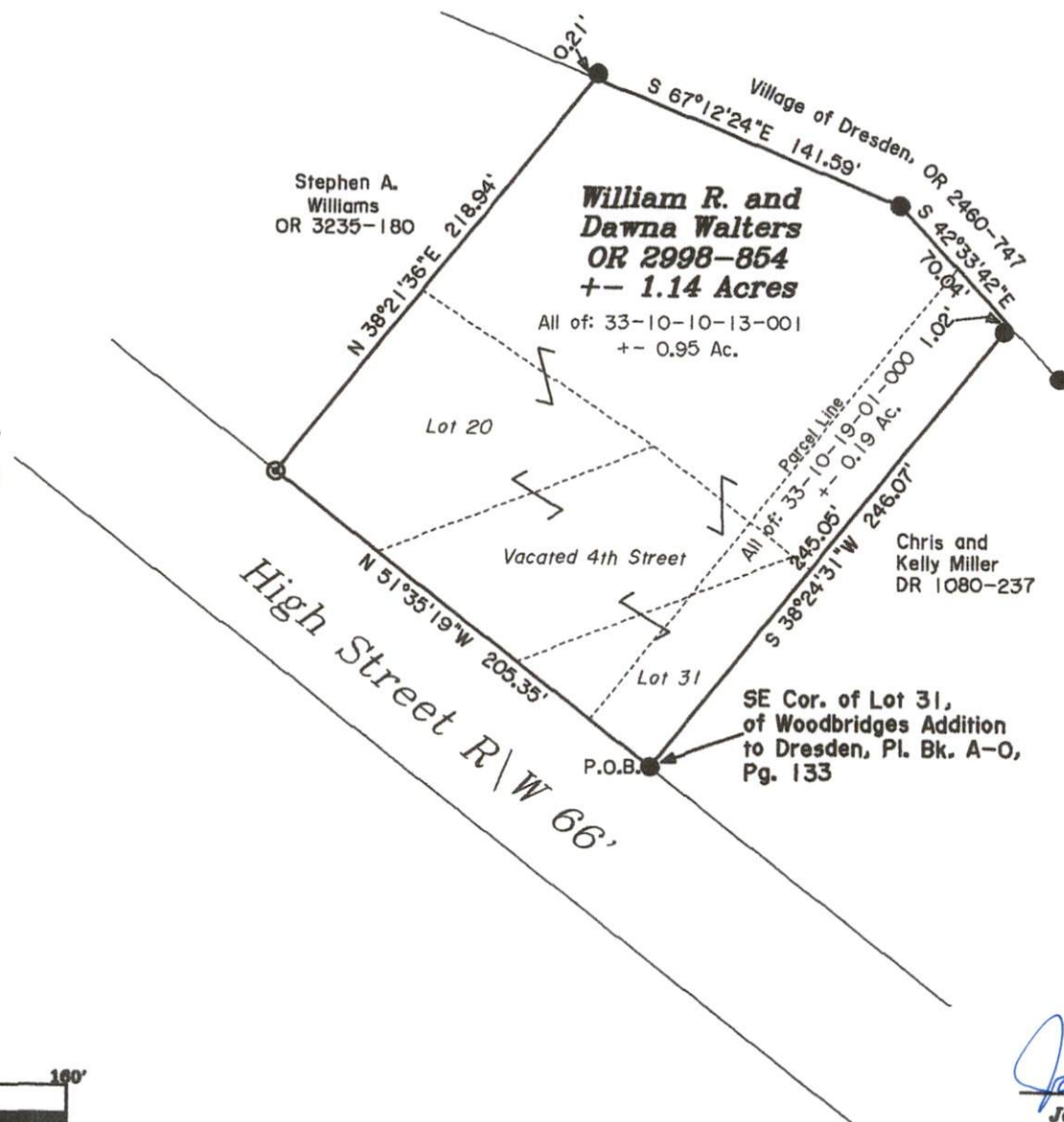
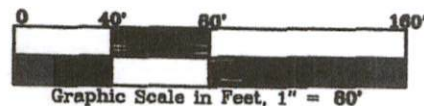




Surveyor's Note:
The Plat of Woodbridges Addition shows the Subdivision line and the south line of the canal lands as being one and the same, but in the field a large area exists between the dimensioned lots and the actual canal line. The Auditor's office is recognizing the area north of the lots as being part of the individuals lands and they are taxed for said lands. The plat was drawn in 1829, and obviously was in error.



SITUATED IN:

State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Village of Dresden, and being all of Lot 20, all of Lot 31, and the portion of Vacated 4th Street, (Ord. No. 93-8, DR 1082-635), lying north of the north line of High Street of Woodbridges Addition to Dresden, (Pl. Bk. A-O, Pg. 133), and an area of land lying north of the dimensioned lots of Woodbridges Addition, and the south line of former Canal Lands, presently owned by the Village of Dresden, (OR 2460-747)

BASIS OF BEARINGS

Bearings are based on the Ohio State Plane Coordinate System, NAD 84(2011), South Zone, Grid North, as per GPS observations.
