Situated in Licking Township, Muskingum County, State of Ohio and being a part of the Second Quarter, Township Two, Range Nine, U.S. Military Lands, more fully described as follows:

Parcel # One

Beginning for a point of reference at a found P.K. nail at the intersection of the centerlines of County Road No. 8 and State Route No. 586, said point being described in the Second Parcel of a deed recorded in Muskingum County Deed Records, Vol. 804, Pg. 90; thence $N 6^{\circ} 22' 52'' W$ along the center line of said County Road No. 8 a distance of 337.85 ft. to a point; thence $N 77^{\circ} 08' 58'' E$ a distance of 95.37 ft. to a point on the East line of the Ohio Canal, said point being the True Point of Beginning of the herein described tract; thence continuing $N 77^{\circ} 08' 58'' E$ a distance of 154.70 ft. to a point marked by a set iron pin, passing a set iron pin at 2.98 ft.; thence $N 2^{\circ} 01' 33'' W$ a distance of 1137.44 ft. to a point on the line common to James E. Lacy and Wilbur A. & Joyce R. Rapp whose title is recorded in Muskingum County Deed Records, Vol. 644, Pg. 82, said point being marked by a set iron pin; thence $N 88^{\circ} 20' 32'' E$ along said common line a distance of 2207.03 ft. to a point, passing set irons at 891.80 ft., 1436.80 ft. and 2201.88 ft.; thence $S 1^{\circ} 13' 58'' E$ along the line common to said Lacy and K. Pound whose title is recorded in Muskingum County Deed Records, Vol. 827, Pg. 242, a distance of 2326.50 ft. to a point

marked by a set iron pin, passing set iron pins at 7.06 ft., 983.50 ft. and 1606.50 ft.; thence S 86° 04' 32" W along said common line a distance of 590.70 ft. to a point marked by a set iron pin; thence S 5° 06' 23" E along said common line a distance of 492.04 ft. to a point marked by a found United States of America monument identified as J 1002-2; thence S 72° 39' 07" W along the line common to said Lacy and United States of America whose title is recorded in Muskingum County Deed Records Vol. 382, Pg. 33, a distance of 1365.94 ft. to a point on the East line of the Ohio Canal, said point marked by a set iron pin, passing a found United States of America pin identified as J 1002-1B at 1251.20 ft.; thence N 18° 25' 44" W along the line common to said Lacy and the State of Ohio a distance of 142.61 ft. to a point marked by a set iron pin; thence N 14° 29' 43" W along said common line a distance of 1855.36 ft. to a point marked by a set iron pin; thence N 40° 41' 32" W along said common line a distance of 97.52 ft. to the True Point of Beginning. Containing 141.4433 Acres, more or less.




