

Description

Situated in Licking Township, Muskingum County, State of Ohio, and being a part of the Second Quarter, Township Two, Range Nine, U.S. Military Lands, being more fully described as follows:

Beginning for a point of reference at a found P. K. nail at the intersection of the center lines of County Road No. 8 and State Route 586, said point being described in the Second Parcel of a deed recorded in Muskingum County Deed Records, Vol. 804, Pg. 90; thence N $13^{\circ}36'14''$ W a distance of 57.84 ft. to a point marked by a set P. K. nail, said point being the True Point of Beginning of the herein described tract; thence to the Right along the curved center line of said St. Rt. 586 to a point, the chord bearing and distance S $13^{\circ}44'48''$ E, 465.22 ft., Radius=3091.5 ft.; thence S $77^{\circ}37'32''$ W a distance of 559.04 ft. to a point marked by a found iron pin, passing a found iron pin at 53.34 ft.; thence S $5^{\circ}02'32''$ W a distance of 50.73 ft. to a point marked by a found iron pin; thence S $79^{\circ}15'32''$ W a distance of 721.52 ft. to a point marked by a found iron pin, said point being the Northwest corner of land described in Vol. 706, P. 49, Muskingum County Deed Records; thence N $1^{\circ}24'22''$ W a distance of 303.95 ft. to a point marked by a found iron

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said point being the Northeast corner of lands described in Vol. 575, Pg. 686, and the Southeast corner of lands described in the first parcel, Vol. 809, Pg. 90, Muskingum County Deed Records; thence $N 1^{\circ} 29' 50'' W$ a distance of 1377.72 ft. to a point marked by a found 2 inch pipe; thence $N 59^{\circ} 00' 38'' E$ along the line common to Lacy lands and those described in Vol. 838, Pg. 10, Muskingum County Deed Records, a distance of 250.00 ft. to a point in the center line of the old Nashport to Black Run Road, said point being marked by a set iron pin; thence $S 20^{\circ} 12' 22'' E$ along the center line of said old road a distance of 163.00 ft. to a point marked by a set iron pin; thence $S 37^{\circ} 59' 22'' E$ along the center line of said old road a distance of 360.00 ft. to a point marked by a set iron pin; thence $S 46^{\circ} 59' 22'' E$ along the center line of said road a distance of 233.00 ft. to a point marked by a set iron pin; thence $S 69^{\circ} 29' 22'' E$ along the center line of said road a distance of 211.00 ft. to a point marked by a set iron pin; thence $S 71^{\circ} 39' 22'' E$ a distance of 55.00 ft. to the point of intersection of the old and new Nashport to Black Run road; thence $S 32^{\circ} 19' 22'' E$ a distance of 410.00 ft. to the True Point of Beginning. Containing 14 acres more or less.
