SURVEY DESCRIPTION

PART OF PARCEL  
#35-35-10-71-16-007 *SNR*

Situated in the South half of Quarter Township #1, T-2-N, R-9-W, U.S.M.L., Muskingum Township, Muskingum County, Ohio. Being part of the lands of Jeffery and Peggy Butler as conveyed in deed book 1063 page 184 of the Muskingum County deed records and being described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin found marking the Southwest corner of lot #5; thence, S.89°32'00"E. a distance of 1,216.78 feet along the South line of said Lot #5, passing a found iron pin at 948.00 feet, to a point in the center of County Road #56 (Shannon Road); thence, S.39°18'00"W. a distance of 111.48 feet along the centerline of said road to a point; thence, S.44°23'16"W. a distance of 397.61 feet along the centerline of said road to a point, BEING THE POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence, S.44°23'16"W. a distance of 129.75 feet along the centerline of said road to a point;

thence, N.48°31'17"W. a distance of 176.63 feet through the lands of J. & P. Butler (1063/184) to a set iron pipe, passing a set iron pipe at 24.77 feet;

thence, N.41°28'44"E. a distance of 129.58 feet through said Butler lands to a set iron pipe;

thence, S.48°31'17"E. a distance of 183.22 feet through said Butler lands, passing a set iron pipe at 157.01 feet, to the point of beginning.

The above described parcel contains 0.535 acres, more or less, and is subject to all legal easements and right of ways. All set iron pipes are 3/4" x 30" pipes with plastic I.D. caps. North is based upon an assumed meridian.
