## DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR RANDY CAVINEE

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Newton:

Being part of the Southwest Quarter, of Section #1, Township #17, Range #15, of the Congress Lands East of the Scioto River, being all of the Robert and Hazel Jones property described in Parcel 2 of Deed Book Volume 565, Page 524 of said county's deed records, known as Muskingum County Auditor's Parcel Number 47-04-01-33-000, and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a stone (found) at the Southwest corner of Section #1, also being the common corner for Sections #2, #11, & #12 of said Township and Range; thence S 90 00 00 E 286.97 feet along the common line for Sections #1 and #12 to the center of Slack Road (Township Road #90) being the place of beginning for the property herein intended to be described;

- #1- thence N 36 52 50 E 147.26 feet into Section #1, along the chord for a curve to the right for said road center line having a radius of 326.75 feet and arc length of 148.54 feet, said center line being the common line for the P & L Slack property described in deed reference Deed Book Volume 520, Page 1161 and said Jones property, to the unmarked PT for said curve;
- #2- thence N 49 54 20 E 84.20 feet continuing along said center line and common line for said Slack and Jones properties to a common corner for said Slack and Jones properties, being on a line of the F. G. Montgomery property described in deed reference Deed Book Vol. 1064, Page 63;
- #3- thence S 00 04 50 E 172.02 feet leaving said road and along the common line for said Montgomery and Jones properties to the South line of Section #1 passing iron pins (set) at 19.58 feet and 167.02 feet;
- #4- thence N 90 00 00 W 153.03 feet along the common line for Sections #1 & #12 to the place of beginning, passing an iron pin (found) at 131.32 feet containing 0.35 acres.

The bearings within the description are based on the South line of Section #1 being East as described in deed references of the area. Bearings are shown in a format of Degrees, Minutes, and Seconds. Iron pins (set) are 5/8" rebar with identification caps (C.R.Harkness P.L.S.6885).
