

Richard and Tamara Roush 0.065 of an acre to be added to 2.92 acres Part of Parcel No. 47-20-01-21-000

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Newton:

Being a part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 7, Township 15, Range 14 of the Congress Lands East of the Scioto River and part of property in the name of Treva M. Thompson, Trustee) (Revocable Trust) and Recorded in Volume 1575, Page 879 of the Muskingum County Deed Records bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a stone found at the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of said section 7; thence N 3°47′28″E (the base of bearings for this description is state plane grid from a solar observation) along the east line of said quarter 1164.39 feet to a mine bolt found; thence S 86°56′55″W 355.42 feet to a rebar found; thence N 5°12′45″W 240.32 feet to a rebar found; thence S 76°12′28″W 245.21 feet to a point by a post; thence N 28°24′04″W 411.39 feet to an iron pin found at the northeast corner of a 2.92 acres parcel owned by Richard and Tamara Roush (Vol. 1589, Pg. 479)and at the true place of beginning for the following described parcel; thence S 58°35′48″W along the north line of said Roush property 365.00 feet to a point in Wesley Chaple Road; thence

N 33°58′55″W along the center of said road and through said Treva M. Thompson, Trustee (Vol. 1575, Pg. 829) 15.60 feet to a point; thence N 61°02′11″E 366.03 feet to the true place of beginning and passing through an iron pin set at 28.87 feet and through an iron pin set at 257.00 feet containing 0.065 of an acre.

Part of Parcel No. 47-20-01-21-000.
