

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Newton:

Being part of the Northeast Quarter, of Section #23, Township #17, Range #15, of the Congress Lands East of the Scioto River, **being part of the Paul and Milzi Walton property** recorded in Deed Book Volume 880, Page 105 of said county's deed records, known as Muskingum County Auditor's Parcel Number 47-34-23-10-001, and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin (set) at the center of Section #23; **THENCE North 03 degrees 51 minutes 20 seconds East 1024.21 feet** along the common line for the Northwest and Northeast Quarters of Section #23 to an iron pin (found) at a common corner for the R & D Sampson property recorded in Deed Book Volume 1096, Page 137, and for the C & C Harkness property recorded in Deed Book Volume 938, Page 209; **THENCE South 86 degrees 07 minutes 50 seconds East 90.75 feet** along a common line for said Sampson and Harkness properties to an iron pin (found) at a common corner for said Sampson and Harkness properties; **THENCE North 03 degrees 51 minutes 20 seconds East 70.00 feet** along a common line for said Sampson and Harkness properties to an iron pin (found) at a common corner for said Harkness and Walton properties and at the place of beginning for the property herein intended to be described;

- #1- **THENCE North 03 degrees 51 minutes 20 seconds East 297.81 feet** along the common line for said Sampson and Walton properties to an unmarked point in the center of Carson Road (Township Road #272), passing an iron pin (found) at 260.05 feet;
- #2- **THENCE South 84 degrees 08 minutes 50 seconds East 51.58 feet** along said road to an unmarked point;
- #3- **THENCE South 13 degrees 44 minutes 00 seconds West 300.47 feet** leaving said road and crossing said Walton property to the place of beginning, passing an iron pin (set) at 22.81 feet **containing 0.18 acres.**

The bearings within this description are based on State Plane Coordinate Grid derived from a Solar Observation (Local Hour Angle Method). Iron pins (set) are 5/8" rebar with identification caps (C.R.Harkness P.L.S.6885).
