- THENCE North 02 degrees 30 minutes 50 seconds Esst 332.62 feet to the place of beginning, passing an iron pin (set) at 291.12 feet, and the South right of way line of Old & New US Route #22 at 293.85, containing 4.60 acres from Parcel #47-34-23-15-000 and 5.96 from Percel #47-34-23-16-000, for a total of 10.56 acres, of which 0.47 acres are within the right of way for US Route #22.
