Township of Newton.

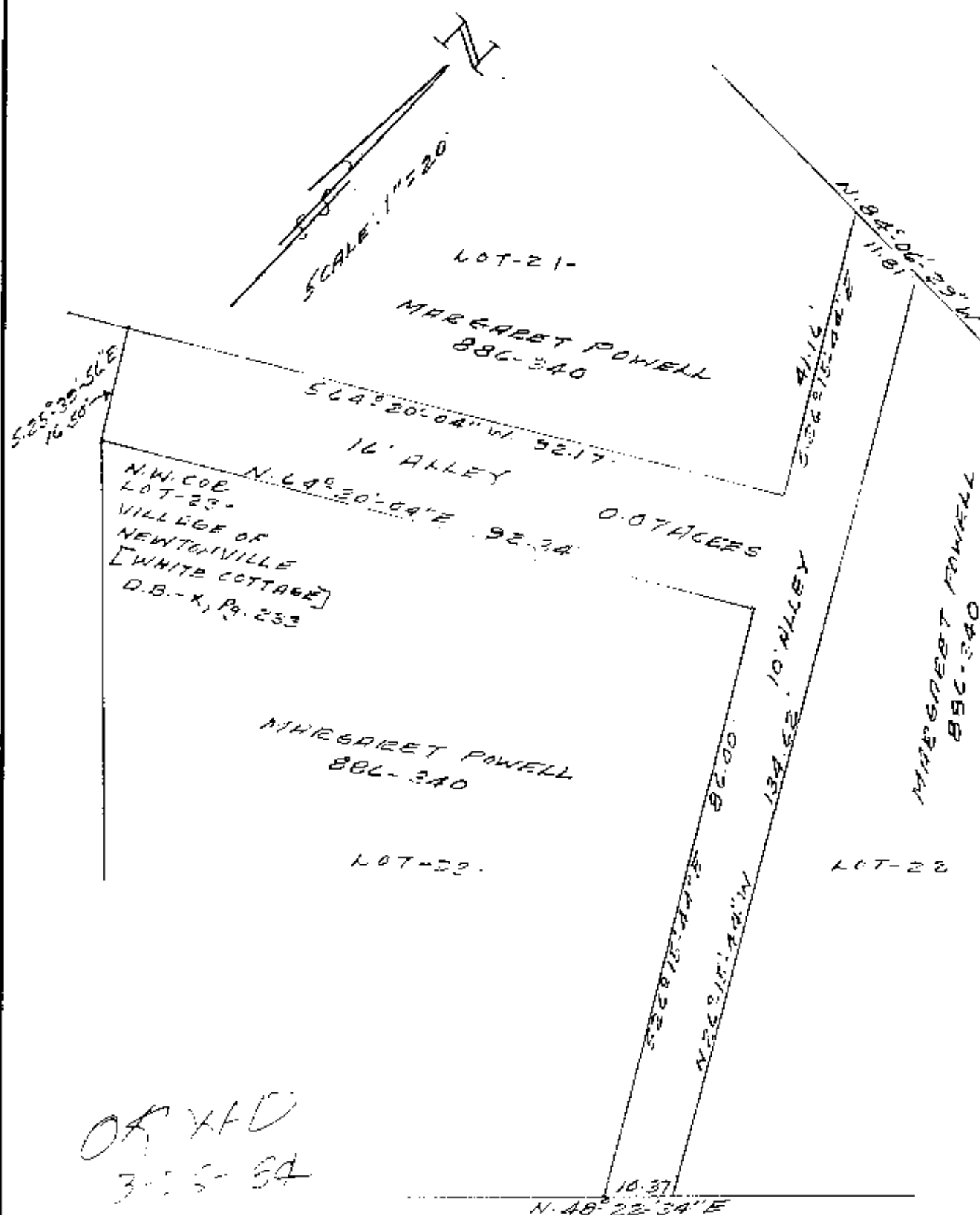
Being in the Village of Newtonsville, now White Cottage

south 26 degrees 15 minutes 44 seconds east along the northerly line  
of said lot 23 a distance of 86.00 feet to a point; thence north 48  
degrees 22 minutes 34 seconds east a distance of 10.37 feet to a point;  
thence north 26 degrees 15 minutes 44 seconds west along the southerly  
line of lot 22 a distance of 134.62 feet to a point; thence north 84  
degrees 06 minutes 29 seconds west a distance of 11.81 feet to a  
point; thence south 26 degrees 15 minutes 44 seconds east along the  
northerly line of lot 21 a distance of 41.16 feet to a point; thence  
south 64 degrees 20 minutes 04 seconds west along the easterly line  
of lot 21 a distance of 92.17 feet to a point; thence south 25 degrees  
39 minutes 56 seconds east a distance of 16.50 feet to the place of  
beginning, containing Seven (0.07) hundredths of an acre more or less.
