DESCRIPTION OF A 30.349 ACRE TRACT OF LAND OWNED BY JOHN F. HALE JR. NEWTON TOWNSHIP, MUSKINGUM COUNTY, OHIO

Situated in the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 15, Range 14, Congress Lands East of the Scioto River, Newton Township, County of Muskingum, State of Ohio, and being 30.349 acres of land all out of that 62.55 acre tract of land owned by John F. Hale Jr., of record in Deed Volume 478, Page 129, and identified as Auditors Parcel # 47-52-24-07, (all references to records being on file in the Office of the Recorder, Muskingum County, Ohio), said 30.349 acre tract being further described as follows:

The Point of Reference being a stone found with a cut -x- at the southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 24, being the northwesterly corner of a 85.24 acre tract of land owned by Jerry F. and Michelli Barstow, of record in Deed Volume 1086, Page 295, said Point of Reference being further referenced by a solid iron bar with an aluminum cap found at the southeasterly corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 24, which bears South 02°33'24" West, at a distance of 2693.11 feet, Thence from said Point of Reference, North 86°45'56" West, along the southerly line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, passing across a 15.37 acre tract of land owned by K. Abram, of record in Deed Volume 557, Page 531, and across Darlington Road, also known as Township Road 46, and along the northerly line of a 90.769 acre Tract 1, owned by Paint Valley Hardwood, LTD., of record in Deed Volume 1975, Page 35, and the northerly line of a 36.225 acre Tract 2, also owned by Paint Valley Hardwood, LTD., of record in Deed Volume 1975, Page 35, and being the southerly line of said 62.55 acre John E. Hale Jr. tract, also being the southerly line of the northwest quarter of said Section 24, a distance of 1840.96 feet to an iron pin set at the southwesterly corner of said 62.55 acre tract, being the southeasterly corner of a 26.05 acre tract of land owned by Arthur and Carol Harris, of record in Deed Volume 1069, Page 459; Thence North 02°45'17" East, along a westerly line of said 62.55 acre tract, being an easterly line of said 26.05 acre tract, a distance of 640.46 feet to an iron pin set and being The True Place of Beginning of the herein described 30.349 acre tract;

Thence North 87°12'12" West, along a northerly line of said 26.05 acre tract, being a southerly line of said 62.55 acre tract, a distance of 477.18 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence North 03°22'16" East, along an easterly line of said 26.05 acre tract, being a westerly line of said 62.55 acre tract, a distance of 509.21 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence North 06°20'40" East, along an easterly line of said 26.05 acre tract, being a westerly line of said 62.55 acre tract, a distance of 146.69 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence North 04°55'33" East, along an easterly line of said 26.05 acre tract, being a westerly line of said 62.55 acre tract, a distance of 131.85 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence South 73°22'17" East, into said 62.55 acre tract, a distance of 269.31 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence North 00°00'00" East, a distance of 219.63 feet to a railroad spike set in the centerline of Darlington Road, also known as Township Road 46;

Thence the following seven courses through said 62.55 acre tract, and being along the centerline of said Darlington Road, 245.05 feet along the arc of a curve to the left, having a radius of 200.00 feet, a central angle of 70°12'06", the chord of which bears South 60°09'12" East, a chord distance of 230.01 feet to a P.K. nail set at a point of tangency;

Thence North 84°44'45" East, a distance of 321.26 feet to a P.K. nail set at;

Thence North 88°22'20" East, a distance of 98.02 feet to a P.K. nail set at a point of curvature;

Thence 243.13 feet along the arc of a curve to the right, having a radius of 376.50 feet, a central angle of 36°59'58", the chord of which bears South 73°07'41" East, a chord distance of 238.93 feet to a P.K. nail set at a point of tangency;

Thence South 54°37'43" East, a distance of 112.68 feet to a P.K. nail set;

Thence South 53°29'20" East, a distance of 148.22 feet to a P.K. nail set;

Thence South 63°10'38" East, a distance of 141.97 feet to a railroad spike set at the southwesterly corner of a 8.0369 acre tract of land owned by Troy A. Erwin, of record in Deed Volume 1553, Page 888;

Thence the following four courses along the centerline of said Darlington Road, being a northerly and easterly perimeter of said 62.55 acre tract, South 68°47'29" East, passing along the southerly line of said 8.0369 acre tract, a distance of 141.00 feet to a P.K. nail set;

Thence South 69°03'30" East, a distance of 260.51 feet to a P.K. nail set;

Thence South 30°52'40" East, a distance of 8.62 feet to a P.K. nail set at the intersection with Restless Road;

Thence South 11°53'35" West, a distance of 283.00 feet to a railroad spike set at the northeasterly corner of a 5.00 acre tract of land owned by C. Rutter, of record in Deed Volume 1028, Page 558;

Thence North 88°38'04" West, along the northerly line of said 5.00 acre tract, and a common line of said 62.55 acre tract, a distance of 389.25 feet to a 5/8" solid iron bar found;

Thence South 17°40'18" East, along the westerly line of said 5.00 acre tract, and a common line of said 62.55 acre tract, a distance of 231.94 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence North 86°45'56" West, a distance of 1026.40 feet to said True Place of Beginning, and containing 30.349 acres of land.

For the purpose of this description, a bearing of North 86°45'56" West was used on the southerly line of that 62.55 acre tract owned by John F. Hale Jr., of record in Deed Volume 478, Page 129, on file in the Office of the Recorder, Muskingum County, Ohio. Said line being the south line of the northwest quarter of Section 24, Township 15 North, Range 14 West. Said bearing being determined by GPS observations, and based upon the Ohio South Zone State Plane Coordinate System, North American Datum of 1983, from monumentation and published values as provided by National Geodetic Survey.

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
