Commencing at an iron pin (found) at the Southeast corner of Lot #10 of Hatchers Addition to East Fultonham as recorded in Plat Book 4, Page 19; thence N 11 56 30 W 172.42 feet along the East line of said Lot #10 to the center line of Old Town Road (County Road #652) (formarly US Route #22 known as the Zanesville Maysville Turnpike), passing an iron pin (found) at 152.02 feet; thence S 77 21 50 W 54.55 feet along the center of said road as established by R. L. Daniels PLS #5410 as part of a survey of the W. Vandegriff property as recorded in deed reference Deed Book Volume 975, Page 253 (formerly the Benjamin Moore 1 acre tract as described in deed reference Deed Book Volume 99, Page 368) to the Southwest corner of said Vandegriff property and the Southeast corner of the J. thence N 73 08 50 E 73.08 feet continuing through said Third Parcel to an iron pin (set) at a common corner for said Third parcel and for said Deed Book Volume 440, Page 321, and on the South line of the Second Parcel of said deed reference Deed Book Volume 571, Page 758;

thence S 20 44 00 E 168.95 feet along the common line for said Third Parcel and Deed Book Volume 440, Page 321 to the place of beginning, passing an iron pin (set) at 138.64 feet, containing 0.263 acres.
