Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Newton, Township 17, Range 15, part of Section 36, and 25, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a stone found at the Southeast corner of Section 36; thence along the Perry County, Clayton Township line South $89^{\circ} 46' 53''$ West 1623.25 feet to an iron pin set in center of old Penn Central right-of-way; thence North $4^{\circ} 57' 04''$ West to an iron pin set in a 2704.33 foot radius curve to the right, the place of beginning; thence along the center of railroad track the following five (5) courses and distances, on a 2704.33 foot radius curve to the right the chord of which ^{bears} North $13^{\circ} 51' 08''$ East 538.70 feet to a point, North $18^{\circ} 36' 07''$ East 2794.23 feet to a point, on a 2875.35 foot radius curve to the ~~left~~ the chord of which bears North $13^{\circ} 21' 54''$ East 537.64 feet to a point, North $8^{\circ} 00' 02''$ East 3266.37 feet to a point and on a 1769.20 foot radius curve to the right the chord of which bears North $19^{\circ} 21' 14''$ East 568.35 feet to an iron pin set from which a stone found at the Northwest corner of Section 30, Township 15, Range 14 bears North $1^{\circ} 24' 41''$ West 652.73 feet, containing 10.51 acres more or less.

Being part of Auditor's Parcel Number 47-47-76-36-15-000.

Bearings are based on the South line of Section 36 bearing South $89^{\circ} 46' 53''$ West.

Iron pins set are No. 5 reinforcing bars 30 inches long with plastic I. D. caps.
