COMMENCING AT A STONE IN THE CENTER OF THE 3<sup>rd</sup> QUARTER OF TOWNSHIP 1; THENCE SOUTH 03 DEGREES 35 MINUTES 30 SECONDS WEST 200.02 FEET TO AN EXISTING IRON PIN (5/8 INCH REBAR);

THENCE SOUTH 02 DEGREES 49 MINUTES 30 SECONDS WEST 508.13 FEET TO AN EXISTING IRON PIN (5/8 INCH REBAR) ON THE SOUTH LINE OF A 6.52 ACRE TRACT CONVEYED TO JOWELL D. DOWNING AS RECORDED IN DEED BOOK VOLUME 1108, PAGE 279 OF THE MUSKINGUM COUNTY DEED RECORDS;

THENCE WITH SAID SOUTH LINE, SOUTH 46 DEGREES 31 MINUTES 24 SECONDS WEST 101.14 FEET TO AN EXISTING CONCRETE HIGHWAY MONUMENT, SAID HIGHWAY MONUMENT ALSO BEING THE PLACE OF BEGINNING OF THE TRACT HEREIN INTENDED TO BE DESCRIBED;

THENCE WITH THE EAST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF STATE ROUTE 797 (AIRPORT ROAD), SOUTH 06 DEGREES 11 MINUTES 40 SECONDS WEST 298.28 FEET TO A POINT;

THENCE NORTH 87 DEGREES 09 MINUTES 40 SECONDS WEST 46.23 FEET TO A POINT IN THE CENTER OF STATE ROUTE 797 (AIRPORT ROAD);

THENCE WITH THE CENTER OF SAID ROAD, NORTH 10 DEGREES 27 MINUTES 45 SECONDS WEST 275.63 FEET TO A POINT, SAID POINT BEING STATION 104+50 OF STATE ROUTE 797 (AIRPORT ROAD);

THENCE LEAVING SAID CENTER, NORTH 79 DEGREES 45 MINUTES 24 SECONDS EAST 130.49 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

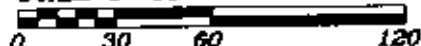

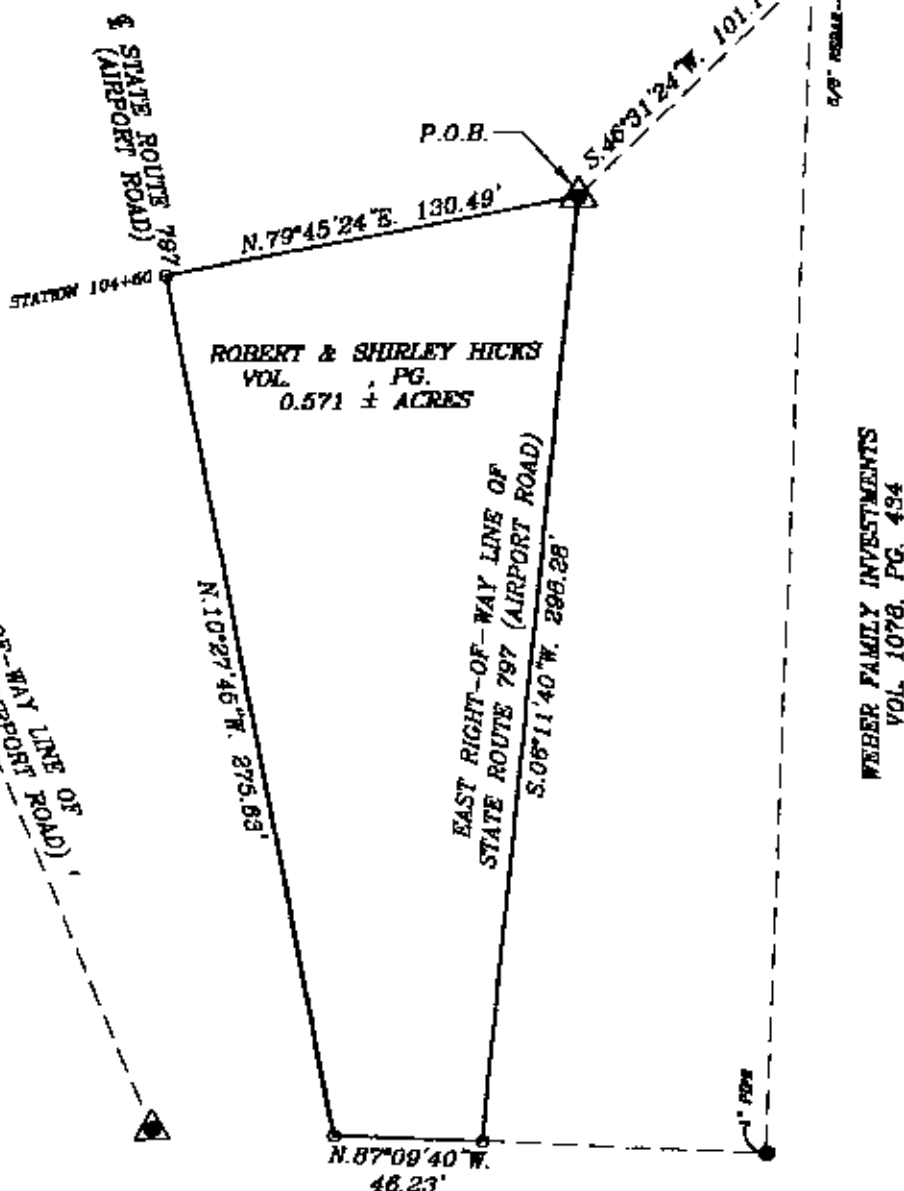
