Being part of the Northwest Quarter, of Section #31, Township #13, Range #11, of the Congress Lands East of the Scioto River, **being part of** the Glenn Kennedy property described in deed reference Official Record Volume 1565, Page 418 of said county's deed records, known as Muskingum County **Auditor's Parcel Number 53-70-31-07-000**, and more particularly described as follows;

Commencing at an iron pin (set) at the Northwest corner of said Section #31, also being the common corner for Section #30 of said Township and Range, and for Sections #25 & #36 of Township #13, Range #12 in Salt Creek Township; THENCE South 87 degrees 12 minutes 20 seconds East 1171.37 feet along the common line for said Sections #30 & #31 to an iron pin (set) being the place of beginning of the property herein intended to be described;

- #1- THENCE South 87 degrees 12 minutes 20 seconds East 370.69 feet continuing along the common line for said Sections #30 & #31 to an iron pin (set);
- #2- THENCE South 20 degrees 10 minutes 20 seconds West 800.88 feet into said Section #31 and through seid Kennedy property to the center line of Big Muskie Drive (State Route #284), passing an iron pin (set) at 772.95 feet;
- #3- THENCE North 60 degrees 19 minutes 20 seconds West 119.51 feet along the center of said road and continuing through said Kennedy property to an unmarked point;
- #4- THENCE North 59 degrees 40 minutes 30 seconds West 155.64 feet continuing along said road and through said Kennedy property to an unmarked point from which an iron pin (set) for reference bears South 25 degrees 24 minutes 40 seconds West 30.00 feet;
- #5- THENCE North 59 degrees 43 minutes 30 seconds West 113.93 feet continuing along said road and through said Kennedy property to an unmarked point;
- #6- THENCE North 22 degrees 52 minutes 40 seconds East 623.71 feet leaving said road and continuing through said Kennedy property to the place of beginning, passing an iron pin (set) at 30.00 feet, containing 6.02 acres
