## DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR DON HITTLE

Being part of the Southwest Quarter, of Section #15, Township #2, Range #6, of the US Military District, **being part of** the Doris Hittle property described in deed reference Deed Book Volume 1145, Page 101 of said county's deed records, known as Muskingum County **Auditor's Parcel Number 56-40-15-18-000**, and more particularly described as follows;

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Section #15, from which a stone (found) on the common line for Salem and Washington Townships of said Muskingum County at the Southeast corner of Lot #1 of the Second Quarter Township of Township #2, Range #7 of said US Military District, bears for reference S 02 36 40 W 198.69 feet; **thence N 02 36 40 E 934.62 feet** along the common line for said Townships to an iron pin (set) at the place of beginning for the property herein intended to be described, passing an iron pin (found) at 594.82 feet, the center line of Adamsville Road (State Route #93) at 621.45 feet, and an iron pin (set) at 652.28 feet;

- #1- thence N 02 36 40 E 313.32 feet continuing along said common line for said Townships to an iron pin (set) at the Southwest corner of the Don Hittle Property recorded in deed reference Deed Book Volume 1096, Page 592, passing an iron pipe (found) at 185.83 feet being the common corner for properties located in Washington Township being the Gary Jadwin property recorded in deed reference Deed Volume 1015, Page 193 and the Goldie Jadwin property recorded in deed reference Deed Book Volume 930, Page 33;
- #2- thence S 81 06 10 E 181.78 feet into Salem Township, Section #15, and along the South line of said Don Hittle property to an iron pin (found) at the Southeast corner of said Don Hittle property, and on the West line of the A Drake property recorded in deed reference Deed Book Volume 983, Pege 204, passing an iron pin (found) at 0.72 feet;
- **#3-** thence **\$ 02 25 30 W 289.69** feet along the common line for said Drake and Doris Hittle properties to an iron pin (set);
- #4- thence N 88 33 50 W 181.67 feet through said Doris Hittle property to the place of beginning, containing 1.25 acres.

The bearings within this description are based on True North derived from survey monuments found as reported in deed reference Deed Book Volume 1047, Page 489. Bearings are shown in a format of Degrees, Minutes, and Seconds. Iron pins (set) are 5/8" rebar with identification caps (C.R.Harkness P.L.S.6885).
