- #9- thence N 72 38 20 W 172.35 feet along a line of said Lowery property to an iron pipe (found), passing a nail (found) at 25.33 feet;
- #10- thence N 83 07 20 W 61.04 feet continuing along said Lowery property to an iron pipe (found);
- #11- thence S 15 53 50 W 29.15 feet continuing along said Lowery property to an iron pipe (found);
- #12- thence N 85 55 20 W 164.71 feet continuing along said Lowery property to the place of beginning, containing 2.99 acres.
