

DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR MARK STINE

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Springfield:

Being part of the Northeast Quarter, of Section #14, Township #16, Range #14, of the Congress Lands East of the Scioto River, being all of Third Tract of the Central Silica Company property described in deed reference Deed Book Volume 566, Page 290 of said county's deed records, also being known as Muskingum County Auditor's Parcel Number 62-50-01-12-000, and more particularly described as follows;

Commencing at an iron pin (found) at the Northeast corner of said Section #14; thence S 00 13 50 E 362.12 feet along the East line of said Section #14 to the Southeast corner of the C & M Dutro property as described in deed reference Deed Book Volume 526, Page 196 and on the North side of the remnants of a Tramway built by the Ayers Mineral Company described in prior deed reference Deed Book Volume 186, Page 70, also being the place of beginning for the property herein intended to be described;

- #1- thence S 00 13 50 E 988.27 feet continuing along the East line of said Section #14 to an iron pin (set) at the extension of the North line of the B & W Thompson properly as described in deed reference Deed Book Volume 1069, Page 61;
- #2- thence N 89 54 40 W 1424.98 feet along the extension and North line of seid Thompson property to an iron pin (set) on the East line of Welters Avenue of Woodside Subdivision as recorded in Plat Book 3, Pages 21 and 24, passing a ½" iron pipe (found) at the Northeast corner of said Thompson property at 256.85 feet:
- #3- thence N 00 00 00 E 361.09 feet along the East line of said Walters Avenue;
- #4- thence N 89 48 40 W 196.46 feet through said Woodside Subdivision to a 2" iron pipe (found) in an existing fence and on the North side of said Tramway, passing a 2" iron pipe at 2.41 feet;
- #5- thence N 61 09 00 E 1025.11 feet leaving said Woodside Subdivision, and along the North side of said Tramway and line of said C & M Dutro property to an iron pin (set);
- #6- thence N 77 01 00 E 497.00 feet continuing along the North side of said Tramway and line of said C & M Dutro property in an iron pin (set);
- #7- thence N 85 37 00 E 236.00 feet continuing along the North line of said Tramway and line of said C & M Dutro property to the place of beginning, passing a 2" iron pipe (found) in said existing fence at 235.13 feet, containing 26.42 acres.

The bearings within the description are based on the West line of Leslie Avenue as shown on the Plat of Woodside Addition as recorded in Plat Book 3, Pages 21 and 24. Bearings are shown in a format of Degrees, Minutes, and Seconds. Iron pins (set) are 5/8" rebar with identification ceps (C.R.Harkness P.L.S.6885).
