Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Northwest Ouarter of Section #1, also being a common corner for the Southwest Quarter of said Section #1 and for the Northeast and Southeast Quarters of Section #2 of said Township end Range, seid corner also being on the line between Springfield and Newton Townships of said County, within the roadbed of Greenhouse Road (Township Road #125), and referenced by an axie (found) on the common line for said Sections #1 & #2 which bears South 00 degrees 51 minutes 50 seconds West 28.45 feet; THENCE South 89 degrees 31 minutes 10 seconds East 717.39 feet along said Township and common line for said Northeast and Southeast Quarters of Section #1, and within the roadbed of said road to the place of beginning of the property herein intended to be described;
