LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Union, and being part of the southeast quarter of Section 14, Township 1, Range 5 of the United States Militery Lands, and being part of those lands intended to be described in Deed Volume 1795, page 618; being further bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at northwest corner of the southeast quarter of Section 14, thence, south 04 degrees – 06 minutes – 35 seconds west, 2220.58 feet to an iron pin found at the northwest corner of those lands now or formerly owned by D. Hoffer (1079/196); thence, south 85 degrees – 53 minutes – 25 seconds east, 409.96 feet to an iron pin found at the northeast corner thereof, and the *true point of beginning* for the parcel herein intended to be described;

Thence, north 04 degrees – 06 minutes – 35 seconds east, 639.42 feet with a new division line through the lands of Russell Moorehead (1795/618) to an iron pin set;

Thence, continuing through said Moorehead lands, north 87 degrees – 56 minutes – 13 seconds east, 400.77 feet to an iron pin set on the west line of those lands now or formerly owned by W. S. Funk (1158/160);

Thence, south 03 degrees – 38 minutes – 04 seconds west, 1108.78 feet along the west line thereof to a point in the center of Zane Trace Road, passing an eight (8) inch corner post et 1088.52 feet;
