## DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR DAVID BARNES

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Union

Being part of the Northwest Quarter, of Section #11, Township #1, Range #5, of the US Military District, being all of the W. Hughes Barnes property described in reference Deed Book Volume 1037, Page 43 of said county's deed records lying in said Section #10, known as Muskingum County Auditor's Parcel Number 66-60-11-18-000, and more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at an iron pin (found) at the Northwest corner of Section #11, also being the common corner for Sections #9, #11 & #12 of said Township and Range;

- #1- thence S 87 52 10 E 2533.23 feet along the common line for said Sections #10 & #11 to the center of Sunflower Drive (County Road #65), passing an iron pin (found) at 2510.34 feet;
- #2- thence S 03 08 00 W 159.30 feet into the Northwest Quarter of Section #11 and along the center of said road to an unmarked point;
- #3- thence S 09 18 10 W 174.52 feet continuing along said road to an unmarked point;
- #4- thence \$ 06 14 40 E 77.32 feet continuing along said road to an unmarked point;
- #5- thence \$ 14 21 50 E 178.32 feet continuing along said road to an unmarked point;
- #6- thence S 09 54 50 E 145.77 feet continuing along said road to an unmarked point;
- #7- thence S 03 52 30 E 70.89 feet continuing along said road to the common line for the Northwest and Northeast Quarters of said Section #11;
- #8- thence S 01 29 10 W 431.15 feet along the common line for said Northeast and Northwest Quarters of Section #11 and within the roadbed of said road to an iron pin (found) in the West edge of said road, also being the Northeast corner of the D Taylor property recorded in deed reference Deed Book Volume 1062, Page 295;
- #9- thence N 87 39 00 W 2615.18 feet along the common line for said Barnes and Taylor properties to an iron pin (set) on the common line for said Sections #11 & #12, also being the common comer for said Barnes and Taylor properties, passing an iron pin (found) at 1311.93 feet;
- #10- thence N 02 13 20 E 1214.08 feet along the common line for said Sections #11 & #12 to the place of beginning containing 71.92 acres.

The bearings within this description are based on the West line of Section #10 as established by Terry L. Steffl PLS #6846 from a Solar Observation (Local Hour Angle Method). Bearings are shown in a format of Degrees, Minutes, and Seconds. Iron pins (set) are 5/8" rebar with identification caps (C.R.Harkness P.L.S.6885).
