DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR KANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Union:

Being part of the Lot #13, Township #1, Range #5 of the US Military District, being part of the Kansas State University property as described in Tract Three of deed reference Deed Book Volume 1083, Page 641 of said county's deed records, said property known as Muskingum County Auditor's Parcel Number (part) 66-90-04-42-000 and more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at a wood post (found) at the Northeast corner of said Lot #13, also being the common corner for Lots #8, #9, & #12 of said Township and Range;

- #1- thence S 02 28 30 W 654.53 feet along the common line for said Lots #12 & #13 to an iron pin (set), passing an iron pin (found) at 5.00 feet;
- #2- thence N 84 50 00 W 2606.66 feet through said Lot #13 and Kansas State University property to an iron pin (set) on the common line for Lot #13 and for Lot #14 also of said Township and Range;
- #3- thence N 01 59 40 E 202.35 feet along said common Lot line to an iron pin (found) at a corner of the Delmus Garber property described in deed reference Deed Book Volume 682, Page 8;
- #4- thence S 83 26 10 E 99.88 feet into said Lot #13 and along a line of said Delmus Garber property to an iron pin (found) at a corner for said Delmus Garber property;
- #5- thence N 67 20 20 E 252.65 feet along a line of said Delmus Garber property to an iron pin (found) at a corner of said Delmus Garber property;
- #6- thence N 16 04 40 W 214.32 feet along a line of said Delinus Garber property to an iron pin (found) on the common line for said Lots #8 & #13 at a corner of said Delinus Garber property;
- #7- thence S 88 10 10 E 2345.48 feet along said common Lot line to the place of beginning containing 32.72 acres.

The bearings within the description are based on State Plane Coordinate Grid derived from an average of numerous Solar Observation (Local Hour Angle Method). Observations were calculated with a range of + or - 27 seconds. Bearings are shown in a format of Degrees, Minutes, and Seconds. Iron pins (set) are 5/8" rebar with identification caps (C.R.Harkness P.L.S.6885).
