BEING A PART OF LOT NUMBER 11 OF A SUBDIVISION MADE BY THE EXECUTORS OF GEORGE JACKSON AND DELINEATED IN THE ALTERATIONS OF LOTS 6, 11 AND 12 IN DEED BOOK "O", PAGE 489 OF THE MUSKINGUM COUNTY DEED RECORDS, SITUATED IN THE 3RD QUARTER OF TOWNSHIP 2, RANGE 7, OF THE UNITED STATES MILITARY LANDS, WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, MUSKINGUM COUNTY, OHIO AND BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SAID LOT NUMBER 11, IN THE CENTER OF STATE ROUTE 666; THENCE ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF SAID LOT, SOUTH 81 DEGREES 00 MINUTES 00 SECONDS WEST 1868.76 FEET TO AN EXISTING IRON PIN (5/8 INCH REBAR) ON THE WESTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY OF THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD (ABANDONED); THENCE WITH THE SAID RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE, WITH A CURVE TO THE LEFT HAVING A RADIUS OF 2880.55 FEET (CHORD BEARING SOUTH 42 DEGREES 16 MINUTES 33 SECONDS EAST 371.33 FEET) AN ARC DISTANCE OF 371.59 FEET TO AN EXISTING IRON PIN (5/8 INCH REBAR) AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF A TRACT CONVEYED TO MAURICE W. AND EVELYN L.
