DESCRIPTION OF A 3.270 ACRE TRACT

Situate in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Washington, and being part of Lot # 21, in the Fourth Quarter Township of Township 2 North, Range 7 West in the United States Military District and being all of the Larry Walls property recorded in Volume # 1554, Page 349, and all of Parcel # 70-09-01-02, of Muskingum County records and being more particularly described as follows ;

Beginning for Reference at the Southwest corner of Section # 25, Township 2 North, Range 6 West, on the Salem Township and Washington Township line between the Third Quarter Township, Township 2 North, Range 6 West and the Forth Quarter Township, Township 2 North, Range 7 West , thence along the Township line North 05 degrees 00 minutes 42 seconds East 1463.28 feet to a stone found with a "t" chiseled on the top, passing an iron pin found at 1247.62 feet ; thence North 85 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 314.91 feet to a point in the centerline of the Adamsville Road (S.R. # 93) ; thence along the centerline of said road South 23 degrees 48 minutes 00 seconds East 226.30 feet to a point in said centerline and the True Place of Beginning ; thence along R.J. Gainer property (Vol.919, Pg. 263), South 26 degrees 15 minutes 48 seconds East 232.00 feet to a point in the centerline of said road ; thence leaving said road along an unplatted subdivision and C. Wheeler property (Vol. 1130 Pg. 169), M. and A. Carpenter (Vol.1734, Pg.178), F.A. and D.J. Keiffer (Vol.658, Pg. 232), D. and H. Grafton (Vol. 1660, Pg. 777), P. & P. Davis (Vol.1056, Pg. 224), R. and T. Rittberger (Vol. 1007, Pg. 127), J.E. and M.K. Bonifield (Vol. 1516, Pg.851) , and M. and D. Maurer (Vol. 1082, Pg. 240) North 84 degrees 57 minutes 15 seconds West 779.00 feet to an axle found , passing a ¾ inch iron pipe found at 44.34 feet ; thence along said unplatted subdivision and D. Findeiss property (Vol. 1677, Pg. 956) and G.S. and B.J. Brewer property (Vol. 862, Pg. 185) North 04 degrees 49 minutes 33 seconds East 198.00 feet to an axle found ; thence along K.E. and Linda S. Madden property (Vol. 836, Pg. 343), South 84 degrees 58 minutes 23 seconds East 659.20 feet to a point in the centerline of the Adamsville Road (S.R. # 93) and the True Place of Beginning, passing an axle found at 624.12 feet.

Containing 3.270 acres , more or less, subject to all easements , restrictions , or right of ways , either written or implied. All iron pins set are # 5 rebar 30 inches long with a yellow I.D. cap labeled "BINCKLEY S - 7879" .
