Commencing at a railroad spike (found) in the top of a wood post being the Center of said Section #9;

- TIE-1 THENCE South 86 degrees 49 minutes 50 seconds East 1143.14 feet along the common line for the Northeast and Southeast Quarters of Section #9 to an iron pin (found) on the West line of the R D Kramer property recorded in Official Record Volume 1736, Page 686;
- TIE-2 THENCE South 03 degrees 48 minutes 45 seconds East 252.90 feet into said Southeast Quarter and along a line of said Kramer property to an iron pin (found);
- TIE-3 THENCE North 86 degrees 11 minutes 15 seconds East 520.12 feet continuing along said Kramer property to an unmarked point in centerline of Church Hill Road (County Road #110), passing an iron pin (found) at 495.12 feet;
- TIE-4 THENCE South 03 degrees 35 minutes 50 seconds West 50.42 feet along said road and common line for said Williams property and for the M Stotts property recorded in Deed Book Volume 617, Page 112 to the unmarked place of beginning for the property herein intended to be described;
- #1. THENCE South 03 degrees 35 minutes 50 seconds West 169.96 feet continuing along said road and common property line to an unmarked point;
- #2- THENCE South 86 degrees 11 minutes 15 seconds West 577.35 feet leaving said road and through said Williams property to an iron pin (set), passing an iron pin (set) at 25.00 feet;
- #3- THENCE North 04 degrees 03 minutes 35 seconds West 168.54 feet continuing through said Williams property to an iron pin (set);
- #4- THENCE North 86 degrees 11 minutes 15 seconds East 600.00 feet to the place of beginning, passing iron pins (set) at 77.59 feet and 575.00 feet, containing 2.28 acres, of which 0.08 acres are within the right of way for Church Hill Road (County Road #110).

The bearings within this description are based on State Plane Coordinate Grid (Ohio South 1983) derived from GPS Observations. Iron pins (set) are 5/8" rebar with identification caps (C.R.Harkness P.L.S.6885).
