

DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR LEAR CORPORATION

JOB#1210-1

Situating in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Wayne:

Being part of the Northwest Quarter, of Section #4, Township #12, Range #13, of the Congress Lands East of the Scioto River, **being part of the H & J McMillan property described in Deed Book Volume 1103, Page 499 of said county's deed records, known as Muskingum County Auditor's Parcel Number 73-03-07-09-000**, and more particularly described as follows;

Commencing at an axle (found) at the common corner for Lots #3 & #5 of Best Subdivision, and on the West Line of Lot #2 of Best Subdivision recorded in Plat Book "A-O", Page 57; **THENCE South 87 degrees 43 minutes 30 seconds East 19.32 feet** along a common line for the United Technologies Automotive, Inc. (UTA) property recorded in Deed Book Volume 1003, Page 255 and the D Gladman property recorded in Deed Book Volume 667, Page 9 to an iron pin (found on the West line of Harris Road also being a corner of a Boundary Line Agreement between United Technologies Automotive, Inc. and H & J McMillan recorded in Deed Book Volume 1136, Page 800; **THENCE North 51 degrees 12 minutes 40 seconds East 184.86 feet** along the West line of said Harris Road and line of said BLA to an iron pin (found); **THENCE along a curve to the left having a chord bearing North 44 degrees 28 minutes 20 seconds East 38.15 feet**, a radius of 215.55 feet, and arc length of 38.20 feet, continuing along said road and BLA to an iron pin (found); **THENCE South 73 degrees 00 minutes 20 seconds East 42.70 feet** continuing along said agreement, and crossing said road to an iron pin (found) on the East line of said road; **THENCE along a curve to the left having a chord bearing North 24 degrees 35 minutes 50 seconds East 98.70 feet**, a radius of 255.55 feet and an arc length of 99.32 feet, along the East line of said road and through said UTA property to an iron pin (set); **THENCE North 78 degrees 55 minutes 00 seconds East 262.49 feet** leaving said road and continuing through said Lear Corporation property to an iron pin (found) at a corner of said BLA; **THENCE North 79 degrees 08 minutes 20 seconds East 176.01 feet** along said BLA, passing from the City of Zanesville into said Section #4, of Wayne Township, to an iron pin (found); **THENCE North 02 degrees 27 minutes 20 seconds East 151.03 feet** continuing along said BLA to an iron pin (set) at the place of beginning for the property herein intended to be described;

- #1- **THENCE North 02 degrees 27 minutes 20 seconds East 35.20 feet** continuing along said BLA to an iron pin (found);
- #2- **THENCE North 54 degrees 57 minutes 20 seconds East 242.69 feet** continuing along said BLA to an iron pin (set)
- #3- **THENCE North 02 degrees 16 minutes 00 seconds East 27.37 feet** continuing along said BLA to an iron pin (set) on the South right of way line for the N & W Railroad;
- #4- **THENCE North 68 degrees 13 minutes 40 seconds East 206.48 feet** along said railroad to an iron pin (set);
- #5- **THENCE along a curve to the right having a chord North 71 degrees 18 minutes 50 seconds East 79.53 feet**, a radius of 738.48 feet, and arc length of 79.56 feet, continuing along said railroad, to an iron pin (set);
- #6- **THENCE South 14 degrees 36 minutes 40 seconds East 180.53 feet** continuing along said railroad to an iron pin (set);
- #7- **THENCE South 49 degrees 25 minutes 40 seconds West 244.61 feet** leaving said railroad and through said McMillan property to an iron pin (set);
- #8- **THENCE North 64 degrees 48 minutes 10 seconds West 329.48 feet** continuing through said McMillan property to the place of beginning, **containing 2.17 acres.**

The bearings within this description are based on State Plane Coordinate Grid derived from a Solar Observation (Local Hour Angle Method). Iron pins (set) are 5/8" rebar with identification caps (C.R.Harkness P.L.S.#6885).
