Thence along the west line of said quarter section, (by deed), North 03 degrees 29 minutes 48 seconds East 2158.54 feet to a point on the southwest corner of lands presently owned by Peggy Marlene Kramer, (OR 1141-756), and in the centerline of North Dietz Road;

Thence along the west line of said Kramer lands, and the centerline of North Dietz Road, North 03 degrees 29 minutes 48 seconds East, 105.73 feet to a point, and the principal place of beginning;

Thence continuing along the west line of said Kramer lands, and the centerline of North Dietz Road, North 03 degrees 29 minutes 48 seconds East, 105.73 feet to a point on the Southwest corner of lands presently owned by Ralph Dean Kramer, (OR 1690-966);
