- **#4- THENCE South 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East 69.00 feet** crossing said Lot #16 and along the West line for said private alley and Baker property to the place of beginning, passing the Northwest corner of said Baker building and property at 4.00 feet, **containing 0.034 acres**.
