DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR STEPHEN WHITE

JOB#438-3

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, City of Zanesville:

Being a survey of that portion of Lot #4 of the Brelsford Subdivision recorded in Plat Book #4, Page #125, owned by Ronald Paul by deed reference Volume 1028, Page 106, which has been identified as being previously used as an alley and more particularly described as follows;

- Beginning at an iron pin (found) at the Northwest corner of said Lot #4;
- #1- thence along the North line of said Lot #4 and the South line of a 10 foot wide alley shown on said Brelsford Plat S 86 31 40 E 15.61 feet;
 - #2- thence through said Lot #4 and along the Southeast side of said area used as an alley and with a curve to the Left having a Radius of 17.50 feet, an Arc length of 16.95 feet, and a Chord bearing S 56 22 04 W 16.29 feet;
 - #3- thence continuing along the Southeast side of said area used as an alley S 28 37 15 W 19.09 feet to the West line of said Lot #4, also being the East line of a 12 foot wide alley shown on said Brelsford Plat;
 - #4- thence along the West line of said Lot #4 and East line of said 12 foot wide alley N 14 56 40 E 27.66 feet to the place of beginning containing 117 square feet.

The bearings within this description are based on State Plane Coordinate Grid derived from a Solar Observation (Local Hour Angle Method). Bearing are shown in a format of Degrees, Minutes, and Seconds.

This description was written by Charles R. Harkness Registered Surveyor #6885 from an actual survey completed on January 30, 1992, and is intended to be used for the legal transfer of the property described and does not intend to describe all or any easements of record, nor encroachments unless otherwise indicated.
