

EDNA MAXWELL
TO
CITY OF ZANESVILLE

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, and in the City of Zanesville and known as being part of the land conveyed by Robert C. Hill and Ethel Hill to Edna Maxwell as recorded in Deed Book 464, page 336 of the Muskingum County records, and more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin found on the Northerly line of Lot No. 15 in Mt. Auburn Addition to the City of Zanesville as recorded in Re-Plat Book 1, page 172 of the Muskingum County records, and the Easterly line of Old Newark Road.

Thence, South 59° - $33'$ - $10''$ East along the Northerly line of said Lot No. 15 a distance of 53.80 feet to a point.

Thence, South 10° - $01'$ - $31''$ West a distance of 460.48 feet to a point on the Southerly line of said Lot No. 15 and the Northerly line of Quarry Alley, 20 feet wide.

Thence, North 60° - $22'$ West along the Northerly line of said Quarry Alley a distance of 42.80 feet to a point on the Easterly line of Old Newark Road.

Thence, North 8° - $46'$ - $51''$ East along the Easterly line of said Old Newark Road a distance of 465 feet to the true place of beginning. Said parcel contains 0.48 acre of land, more or less, as prepared by John David Jones, registered Surveyor and Engineer, in May 1983.
